If you have a specific concern or hazard, then we would encourage you to either send us photos or, if you prefer, request a video chat wherein you will have the capability to display the facility, grounds or equipment in question, via your video-based platform of choice, and discuss potential mitigation actions with us.

During these virtual meetings, we can also conduct a general risk management review with you. This would include discussing the systems you should have in place to mitigate risk such as recommended policies, safety/risk management programs and training programs. We can also discuss the specific areas where the insurance program is experiencing losses to help raise your awareness of the potential risks your district may be facing.
