WOOD SHOP SAFETY




DEVELOP shop safety and rules - for example:

- · District specific policies
- Emergency procedures
- Training and testing processes for machine use
- · Use of PPE including always wearing protective eyewear
- · Limit access if tardy
- Appropriate clothing no open-toed shoes or loose-fitting clothing
- · Machine guards
- Limit interactions with people using machines
- Do not leave the machine while it is running
- · When appropriate, securely attach machines to floor
- Liability considerations for afterhours use or use of shop by non-employees
- Any donated tools and machines should be inspected by a competent person
- · No loose hair or jewelry
- VERIFY fire extinguishers, general maintenance, filter changes and general operation of equipment is up-to-date

- · Tool maintenance and sharpening
- General housekeeping including clean up and returning tools to proper storage
- No horseplay
- Immediately take out of service any machine or tool that is broken
- Lock out/tag out for machines that are off limits to students or in need of repair
- · Consider first aid training for all users
- First aid equipment and supplies
- · Always get help for special projects and questions
- Know all specific safety rules and machine use for each piece or machinery and all hand tools
- · Don't allow tools or machines from home
- Store all backpacks, coats, etc. before entering workspace
